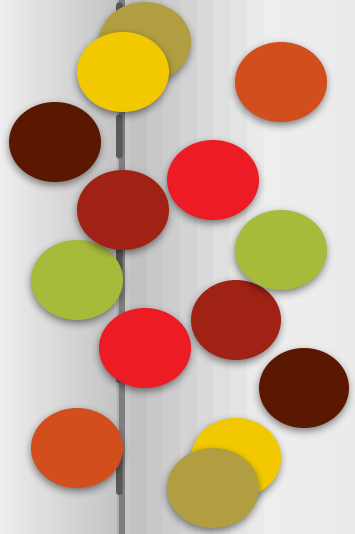


My Trip to the Southeast

Jamestown, Virginia

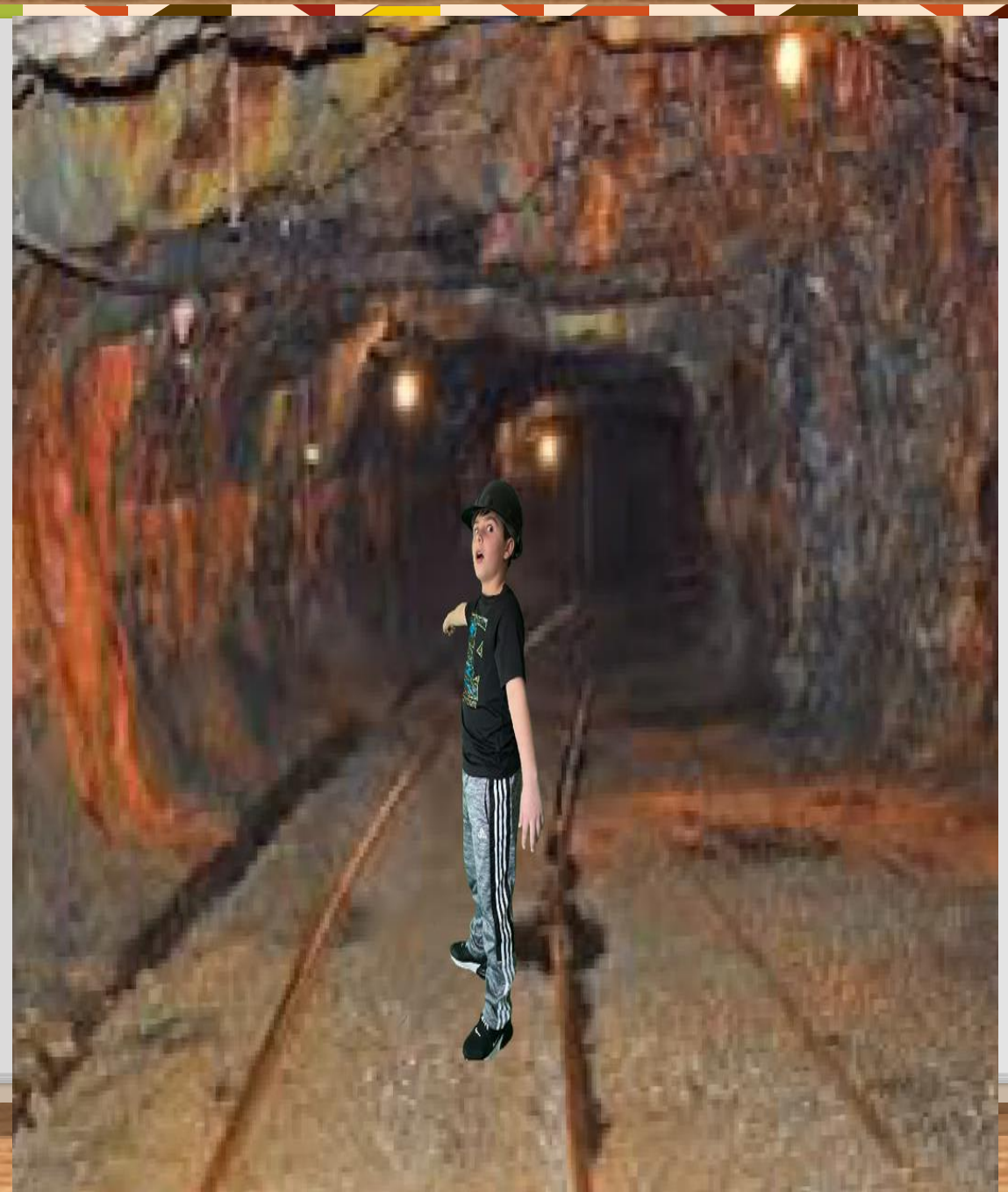
