
Kennedy Space Center


A coal mine in Appalachia

Today I went o a coal mine in Appalachia. The location is important because Coal is used to heat homes and produce energy and there is coal there. It is too hilly for large-scale farming.








A Cotton Plantation in Natchez, Mississippi
