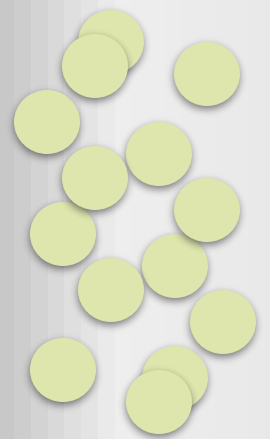


# **My Trip to the Southeast**
