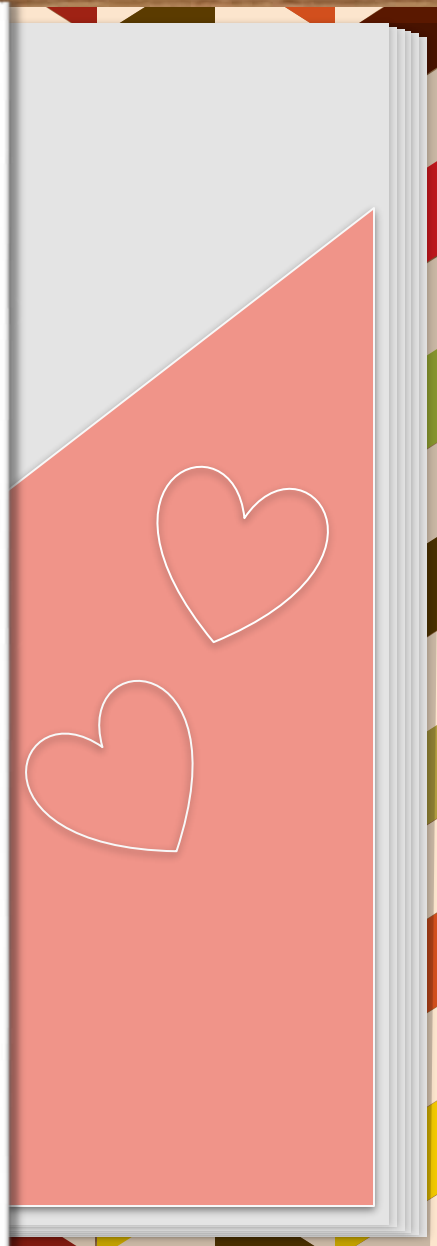


# My Trip to the Southeast
