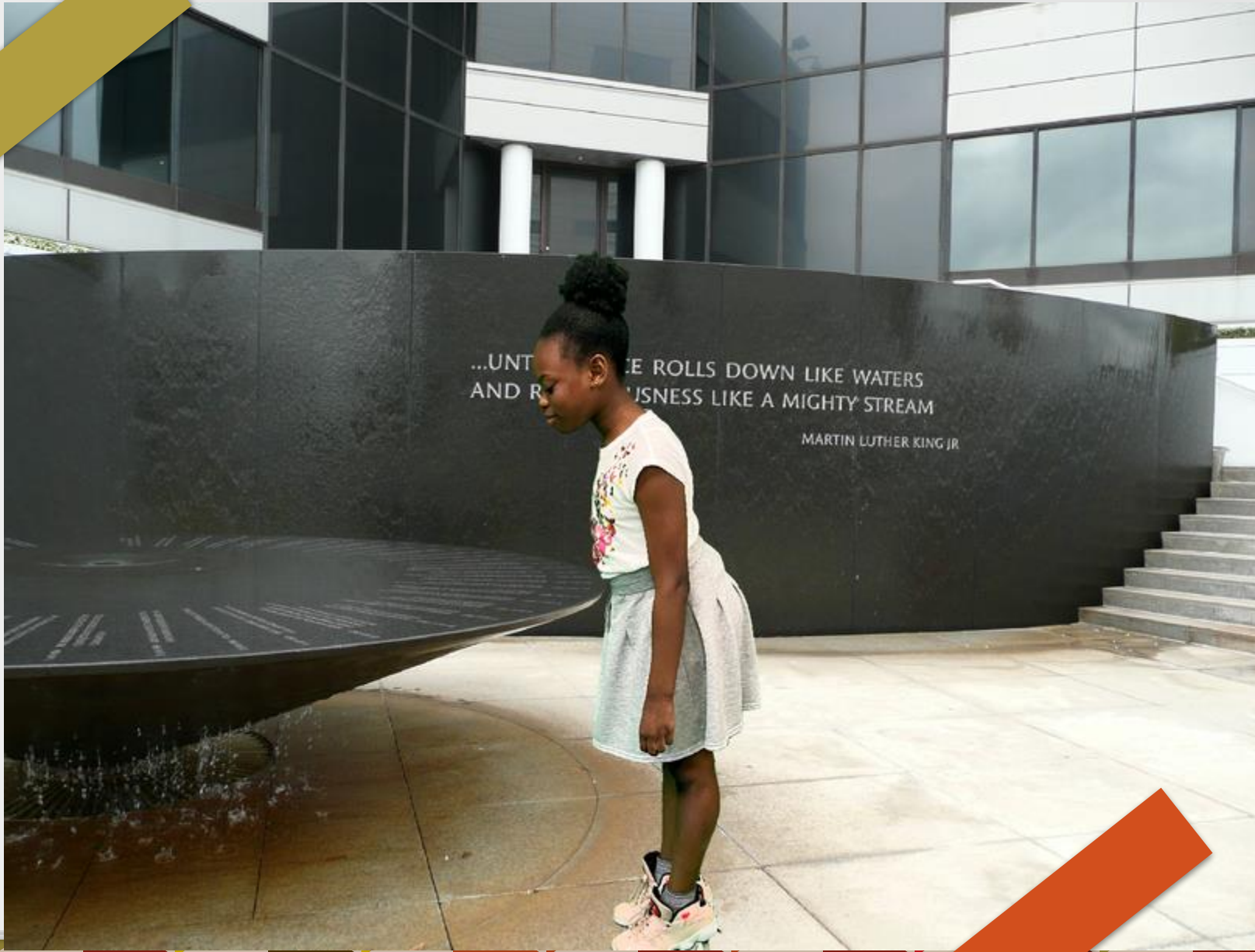




# Cotton Plantation.

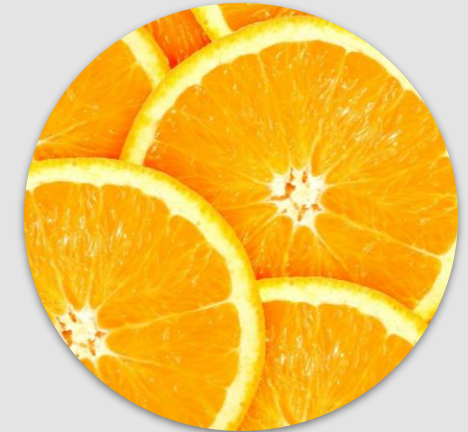
